## Personal Visits

Home visitors share age-appropriate child development information, help parents learn to observe their own children, address their parenting concerns, and engage the family in activities that provide meaningful parent-child interaction.

## Group Meetings

Parent group meetings provide opportunities to share information about parenting issues and child development. Parents learn from and support each other, observe their children with other children, and practice parenting skills.

## Screening

Periodic developmental, health, vision and hearing screening provides for early identification of developmental delays and health problems. Regular review of each child's progress identifies strengths and abilities as well as areas of concern that require follow-up services while increasing the parent's understanding of typical development.

## Resource Network

Parent educators help families identify and connect with needed resources and agencies.

## Cultural Competency Vision

All cultures are openly welcomed and valued. Multiculturalism is appreciated and practiced to enhance the value of our work through respectful curiosity of one another's culture and developing a reciprocal relationship of mutual caring and learning.
