NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILL - **CLEAN HARD FILL**

O.A.C. 3745-400-05

For the purpose of changing grade on a site, other than the removal site, clean Hard Fill is defined as:

Construction and demolition debris, which consists only of reinforced or non-reinforced concrete, asphalt concrete, brick, block, tile, and/or stone which can be re-utilized as construction material. Brick in clean hard fill includes, but is not limited to, refractory brick and mortar.

Clean hard fill **does not include** materials contaminated with hazardous wastes, solid wastes, or infectious wastes (O.A.C. 3745-400-01(E)).

The person responsible for causing clean hard fill to be used to change grade on a site other than the site of removal, shall provide a written "Notice of Intent to Fill", to the Trumbull County Combined Health District, if the fill is to be placed on a site within the jurisdiction of the Trumbull County Combined Health District.

Only those items listed above may be used for this purpose. Any other wastes used as fill shall be considered an Open Dumping Violation (O.R.C. 3734.03) and would constitute enforcement action. Clean hard fill may be stored for a period less than two years. Clean hard fill stored more than two years, shall be considered illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris (O.A.C. 3745-400-05(B)).

3745-400-05 (A) Clean hard fill consisting of reinforced or non-reinforced concrete, asphalt concrete, brick, block, tile, or stone shall be managed in one or more of the following ways:
3745-400-05 (C) (4) Used in legitimate fill operations for construction purposes or to bring the site up to a consistent grade, on a site other than the site of generation, pursuant to paragraph (C) of this rule.

Any changes to the above information shall require a new Notice of Intent to be completed. This form must be submitted at least seven (7) days prior to filling project start date.
