

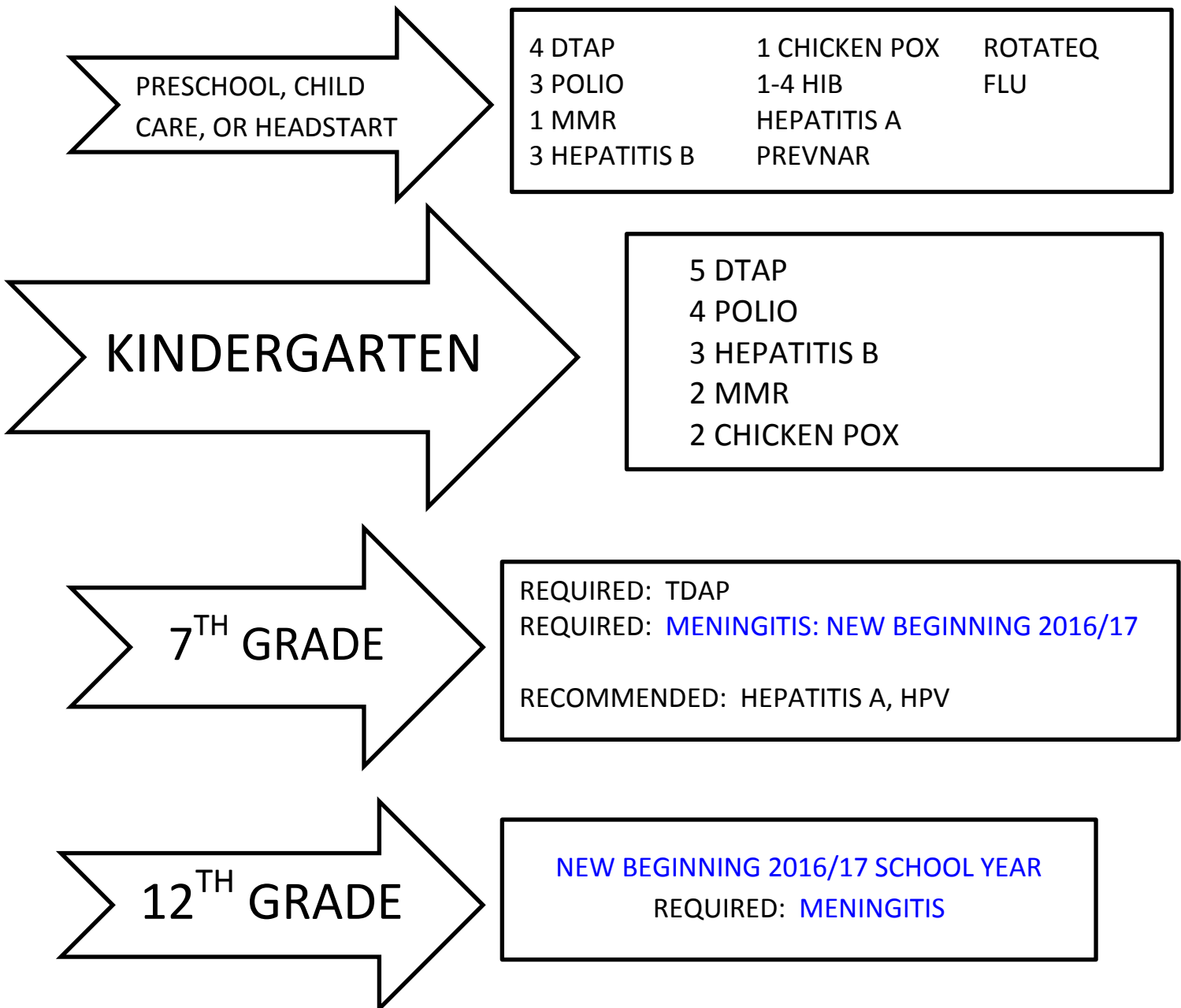


Don't Delay, Call Today!

ARE YOU READY FOR YOUR FUTURE?

Many people between the ages of 11 and 18 think they are done with their vaccinations. They think vaccinations are just for little kids. But guess what? There are millions of people between the ages of 11 and 18 who need vaccinations to prevent whooping cough, tetanus, diphtheria, hepatitis B and meningococcal disease and more. Are you one of them?

Getting immunized is a lifelong, life-protecting job. Check now to be sure you've had all the vaccinations you need and your future health will be secure. The following vaccines are the ones that can prevent serious diseases that are too dangerous to ignore:

HepatitisB (HepB)	You need a series of 3 doses of HepB vaccine.
Tetanus, diphtheria, Pertussis(whooping cough) (Tdap, Td)	You need a booster dose of Tdap at age 11-12 years. If you're older and already had a Td booster, you should get a Tdap shot to get the extra protection against pertussis. After that you will need a Td booster dose every ten years.
Meningococcal disease	This vaccine is required for all teens ages 11 or 12 years with a booster dose after 16 years.
Varicella	If you have not been previously vaccinated and have not had chickenpox, you should get vaccinated against this disease. The vaccine is given as a 2-dose series. Any teenager who was vaccinated as a child with only 1 dose should get a second dose now.
HPV	Human Papillomavirus Vaccine is recommended for girls and boys 9yrs to 26yrs. It is a series of 3 doses.
Hepatitis A	A series of 2 doses recommended for age 12mo and up.

There are more vaccines available to you. Check with your healthcare provider, your local health department and your college and/or employer requirements.

Please don't delay in getting your needed vaccines. If you act now it will not only protect you from diseases but it will also protect your pocketbook. If you receive any of these vaccines before your 19th birthday they will only cost you **\$21.25 per visit** (for state provided vaccine). Price at 19 years will be full purchase price of the vaccine.
